Attached for your information is a notice to the APWU regarding changes at the AMC/AMF/ATOs.

Also enclosed is a list of the AMCs that are being reviewed at this time.

As the letter to President Burrus states, the intent of the service is to remove all mail processing functions from the AMCs and return them to the P&Ds.

Whether this will happen in every site and if so when, is yet to be determined.

What should remain are the:

- 1. tender and receipt of mail
- 2. ramp activities
- 3. retail (where applicable)
- 4. remaining PVS shuttle runs

Depending on the status of the AMC, for contract administration purpose, whether it's a facility or stand-alone installation, will determine the application of Article 12 if necessary.

Above and beyond the movement of mail processing back to the plants, there may be some Article 32 issues that may develop as well as impact on other crafts.
